ERONGO WILDERNESS LODGE

Luxuriate in the richness of nature

Erongo Wilderness Lodge is situated in the Erongo Mountains and forms part of the 200 000 hectare Erongo Mountain Nature reserve. A natural reserve within a vast volcanic crater complex, it boasts unparalleled biodiversity and is renowned as a birding 'hotspot'

The Erongo Mountains are centrally situated and easily included in any itinerary around this magnificent country. The Erongo Mountains are best accessed via the quaint town of Omaruru which is situated on the C33, a tarred road connecting the towns of Karibib & Otjiwarongo. The town of Omaruru is an easy 2 ½ hour drive from either Windhoek or Swakopmund; a tarred road will lead you to Etosha in about 3 to 4 hours. A scenic drive will get you to Twyfelfontein in about 3 hours. For those not travelling to Swakopmund, a stunning 4 to 5 hour drive will get you to Sesriem to explore the Sossusvlei area.
